



AMOS: A WAKE-UP CALL FROM GOD

This Fall, Pastor Jensen is presenting a Sunday morning message series at the 8:00 and 10:30 AM Worship Services based on the Book of Amos that will extend into the new year. The book of Amos is relevant to our world today. It offers prophetic warnings against the practices of idolatry, greed and oppression. Amos addresses God's enemies, but he really zeroes in on speaking to God's people, Israel. In our world today, God's enemies and His people, especially His people, need to "wake up" and repent of the wickedness that God abhors and embrace justice and righteousness which are the foundation of His throne. This is the essence of Amos's wake-up call from God. The mess of mercy

The reformer Martin Luther once dreamed that he saw Jesus approaching his door. Luther panicked, seeing that his home was an absolute disaster inside. "How am I going to let the Lord of Life, Jesus Christ, come into a mess like this?" he wondered.

Luther raced to clean up, but the mess only increased. As Jesus knocked, Luther was resigned. "Come on in, if you think you can come into a place like this," he told Jesus ... only to turn around and see that everything was now in order. All Luther had to do was let Jesus enter.

"Mercy is always a messy business," writes pastor Daniel Emery Price at 1517.org. That's true of the Reformation, just as it was when Jesus cleared moneychangers out of the temple. "There will always be those who condemn the mercy because of the mess," notes Price. "Reformation is always about clearing the path to God's radical grace."

Rivers of living water

John 7:38 - Whoever believes in me, as the Scripture has said, 'Out of his heart will flow rivers of living water.'1

A river touches places of which its source knows nothing, and Jesus says if we have received of His fulness, however small the visible measure of our lives, out of us will flow the rivers that will bless to the uttermost parts of the earth. We have nothing to do with the outflow—"This is the work of God that ye *believe…"* God rarely allows a soul to see how great a blessing he is.

A river is victoriously persistent, it overcomes all barriers. For a while it goes steadily on its course, then it comes to an obstacle and for a while it is baulked, but it soon makes a pathway round the obstacle. Or a river will drop out of sight for miles, and presently emerge again broader and grander than ever. You can see God using some lives, but into your life an obstacle has come and you do not seem to be of any use. Keep paying attention to the Source, and God will either take you round the obstacle or remove it. The river of the Spirit of God overcomes all obstacles. Never get your eyes on the obstacle or on the difficulty. The obstacle is a matter of indifference to the river which will flow steadily through you if you remember to keep right at the Source. Never allow anything to come between yourself and Jesus Christ, no emotion, or experience; nothing must keep you from the one great sovereign Source.

Think of the healing and far-flung rivers nursing themselves in our souls! God has been opening up marvelous truths to our minds, and every point He has opened up is an indication of the wider power of the river He will flow through us. If you believe in Jesus, you will find that God has nourished in you mighty torrents of blessing for others.







Prayer, Fasting and Casting a Vision - UPDATE

The Administrative Board and the Vision Task Force continue to work together to dialogue about where God may be leading our congregation. The leadership identified these areas as initiatives that God may be calling us to pursue. These include 1) remodeling and expanding the Kitchen, 2) enhancing security measures during public events and 3) implementing some sort of alternative education program such as a Christian Micro-school for parents who are looking for options beyond the public school system.

Members of the Administrative Board and the Vision Task Force recently met with representatives from Noelker and Hull Associates, an architectural firm. As you may recall from last month's article, The Board took formal action to contract with Noelker and Hull to perform a feasibility study on proposed changes to the upper level. These changes include moving the church offices upstairs and freshening the upper level bathrooms, gathering areas and rooms. This summer, they took a tour of our facilities to generate some ideas for us to consider. At the recent meeting, ideas were shared back and forth with Noelker and Hull so that they can provide formal recommendations to the Task Force and the Board. A meeting where those recommendations are shared will be coming in the not-so-distant future.

At its regular meeting on September 12, the Administrative Board gave its blessing to form a Microschool Sub Task Force to work directly with the Vision Task Force. The Sub Task Force will do the "leg work" regarding the formation of a Christian Microschool under the direction of the Vision Task Force and the Administrative Board. Our Director of Children and Youth Ministries, Jill Kilker and I will approach prospective persons to serve on the Sub Task Force.

Regarding the Christian Microschool initiative, I give thanks to the Lord for some individuals who recently approached me about supporting the school initiative by way of estate planning or Pennsylvania's "Educational Improvement Tax Credit" program. You may recall back in January that we hosted two seminars regarding the Tax Credit program. I still have informational packets in case anyone wants to participate in the program or simply find out more information. See me and I will be happy to give you a packet.

Please continue to be in prayer asking God to guide us so that we will go forward according to His will and purpose. Pray that He will open and shut doors accordingly.


