






- Large bowl

AMOS: A WAKE-UP CALL FROM GOD

This Fall, Pastor Jensen will begin a Sunday morning message series at the 8:00 and 10:30 AM Worship Services based on the Book of Amos. This series is lengthy – we will start it in September and take a break from it during Advent and Christmas. Then, we will resume the series in the new year. The book of Amos is relevant to our world today. It offers prophetic warnings against the practices of idolatry, greed and oppression. Amos addresses God's enemies, but he really zeroes in on speaking to God's people, Israel. In our world today, God's enemies and His people, especially His people, need to "wake up" and repent of the wickedness that God abhors and embrace justice and righteousness which are the foundation of His throne. This is the essence of Amos's wake-up call from God. 

Prayer, Fasting and Casting a Vision - UPDATE

The Administrative Board and the Vision Task Force continue to work together to dialogue about where God may be leading our congregation. The leadership identified these areas as initiatives that God may be calling us to pursue. These include 1) remodeling and expanding the Kitchen, 2) enhancing security measures during public events and 3) implementing some sort of alternative education program such as a Christian Micro-school for parents who are looking for options beyond the public school system.

Recently, Deacon Rich Kreiger and Administrative Assistant Amy Kreiger met with representatives from Noelker and Hull Associates, an architectural firm, here at ECOG. The purpose of the meeting was to give the architectural firm access to ECOG so that they could provide initial recommendations to the leadership regarding relocation of the offices and a general "freshening up" to the upper level which will be necessary to accomplish vision area #3 above (a Christian Micro-school). Rich and Amy reported back to the Administrative Board at its regular meeting on August 13 and provided a proposal from the architectural firm. The Board took formal action to contract with Noelker and Hull to perform a feasibility study on changes to the upper level. As was reported last month in The Sonshine News, funds to pay for this study will be taken from the Building Fund.

Please continue to be in prayer asking God to guide us so that we will go forward according to His will and purpose. Pray that He will open and shut doors accordingly.






